All Blood Types needed. You can donate blood every 56 days. Picture ID required.

To donate blood, you must be in good health, at least 17 years of age and a minimum of 110 pounds. 16-year olds who weigh at least 130 pounds can donate with a signed Blood Center parental consent form. Go to www.thebloodcenter.org to download a copy. There is no upper age limit. Individuals with high blood pressure (below 180/100) or controlled diabetes can now donate. You cannot donate if you have been exposed to hepatitis or taking a heart medication. If you were out of the country between 1980 to 1996 for more than 3-6 months, please call the Mandeville Donor Center at 985-377-7007 to determine if you can donate. There are areas that are still high risk for malaria that may require a one-year waiting period. It is recommended that you eat a good meal before donating and drink plenty of water to hydrate your veins.
