# GUIDE TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY

## Your party determines what's on your ballot.

### If you're registered with the DEMOCRATIC PARTY, you can vote for:

- Democratic presidential nominee.
- Democratic State Central Committee and Democratic Parish Executive Committee, if any such election is on the ballot in your parish.
- Municipal, special, or proposition election, if any such election is on the ballot in your parish and if you are eligible to vote within the jurisdiction of the municipal, special, or proposition election.

### If you're registered with the REPUBLICAN PARTY, you can vote for:

- Republican presidential nominee.
- Republican Parish Executive Committee, if any such election is on the ballot in your parish.
- Municipal, special, or proposition election, if any such election is on the ballot in your parish and if you are eligible to vote within the jurisdiction of the municipal, special, or proposition election.

### If you're registered with ANY OTHER PARTY, or have NO PARTY affiliation, you can vote for:

- Municipal, special, or proposition election, if any such election is on the ballot in your parish and if you are eligible to vote within the jurisdiction of the municipal, special, or proposition election.
- The precinct register will state "NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION" on the signature line if you do not live in the jurisdiction of any municipal, special, or proposition elections on the ballot.

**NOTE: Provisional ballots are available for Democratic and Republican presidential nominees ONLY.**
