


Acting in accordance with La. Const. Art. V, Sec. 1 and the inherent power of this Court and considering the emergency created by the expected hazardous weather conditions forecasted for this court's jurisdictional area in connection with Tropical Storm/Hurricane Ida and, further, in consideration of the unsafe conditions caused therefrom and the Court's immediate concern for the community's safety and well-being;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the 22nd Judicial District Court for the Parishes of St. Tammany and Washington and the St. Tammany Parish Clerk of Court's office and the Washington Parish Clerk of Court's office shall be closed Friday, August 27, 2021, at 2 p.m., and will reopen on Tuesday, August 31, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. unless extended by further order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all civil matters, and child support matters noticed for Monday, August 30, 2021, will be reset and notice given. Any defendants scheduled to appear on Monday, August 30, 2021, for criminal court, or misdemeanor court, should report to the courthouse between September 8, 2021, and September 10, 2021, to be re-served with a new court date. Video court hearings with the jail by Zoom are canceled for Monday, August 30, 2021.
