ELEVENTH AMENDMENT TO COURT'S ORDER OF MARCH 13, 2020 RE: CORONAVIRUS

Acting under the authority of Article V, Section 1 of Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the announcement made by Governor John Bel Edwards on October 26, 2021 and Proclamation Number 203 JBE 2021 regarding the lifting of the state-wide mask mandate;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the mask mandate is lifted as it relates to those individuals seeking entrance to the St. Tammany Parish Justice Center and Washington Parish Courthouse. However, pursuant to Proclamation Number 203 JBE 2021, all individuals, especially those most vulnerable, are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings while interacting with members of the public.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following safety measures are recommended in the common areas of the Courthouse: six feet social distancing be maintained by individuals who are not in the same household, and temperature checks at the courthouse entrance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each judge retains the discretion and authority to require masks and/or social distancing in his or her courtroom, chambers, the jury pool room and any other area designated for the jury qualification process.
