

Microsoft Windows 11 Support

Microsoft released Windows 11 in October 2021. Windows 11 is not currently supported by The Clerk of Courts IT Services Team for use on any of our on-line or on-premises applications. Once this process is complete, we will update this web page with the latest supported version information. The Clerk of Courts IT Services Team will not provide support, network connectivity for Windows 11 machines until we complete compatibility testing with our network, applications, and core IT services. If you need access to our applications in the meantime, our advice would be to not upgrade to Windows 11 until the applications are approved.

Our IT Services Team has been testing all of our applications for Windows 11 compatibility along with a variety of commonly deployed applications. Tests will be conducted using a variety of currently supported Dell desktop and laptop computers with a fresh install of Windows 11. Applications are also being tested on an in-place Dell supported computer upgraded from a managed Windows 10 install to Windows 11. Details of what was tested for each application will be available once testing is complete.

Recommendation

The Clerk of Court's IT Services team recommends against upgrading to new Windows versions until all relevant Clerk on-line services applications have been validated as functional. Even once functionality is confirmed, users should always carefully consider their needs before upgrading. It is often best to delay OS upgrades until at least the first major update has been released by the vendor.
