


Figure 2: Supplemental List Envelope (L-SL)


Figure 7: Notation of Irregularities Form

- B. If the envelope contains a List of Persons Voting Absentee-by-Mail, you must document this information in the precinct register as follows:
  - For each name on the List of Persons Voting Absentee-by-Mail, write, "voted absentee" in the place where the voter usually signs the precinct register; then write your initials beside the words "voted absentee." The commissioner who marks the voters who voted absentee and places their initials in the precinct register should also place their initials on the supplemental list of persons voting absentee-by-mail.



Page 32 - B. 1. For each name on the List of Persons Voting Absentee-by-Mail, write, "voted absentee" in the place where the voter usually signs the precinct register.


Page 41 - The Precinct Register Correction (PRC) form now has a spot to indicate the voter's lockout button number. Only the ROV or SOS may authorize the use of a PRC, and they will provide the button number if the voter has a lockout.

2. The commissioners shall not allow more than one person to enter a voting machine at a time, except when a voter is entitled to assistance; however, a minor may accompany their parent or legal guardian. Recommend that the child stay to the left of the parent so that they do not accidentally press the orange CAST VOTE button before the parent has made all of their selections and completed voting.



Page 51 - E 2. Indicates that a minor may accompany their parent or guardian in the voting machine. (previously 12 year old)

3. A voter is allowed six (6) minutes to vote, unless they are using the audio ballot or needing assistance, in which case they may have a maximum of twenty (20) minutes. Encourage voters to review the sample of the official ballot posted at the precinct or on their smartphone in the GeauxVote app, which can be marked online and used in the voting booth. If the ballot is lengthy or if it contains complex propositions or constitutional amendments, the commissioners may allocate additional time in an equitable manner.



Page 51 - E 3. Indicates that a voter is allowed 6 minutes in the voting machine. (previously 3 minutes)
